




What are Interactive Oral (IO) assessments?

An Interactive Oral Assessment (IOA) approach is a genuine, unscripted, synchronous conversation between an assessor and a student (or a group of assessors/students) around an 'authentic workplace/professional scenario' (Sotiriadou et al., 2019) which can be performed face-to-face or online






Rationale for using IOs

- authentic assessment
- a personalised approach to learning and teaching
- preserves academic integrity.
- promotes skill development and employability, student engagement
- facilitates higher-order thinking
